- c) Hemming Sivertsen was named Sjursen Hemmingsen in error in "Early Hemmingsen Ancestry; Circles of Norway"



- 1 Sivert Hemmingsen died in Stjordal in 1841. He and Mali C. had 4 children: Hemming 1826, Anders 1829, Gurina 1832, Sigrid 1836. Mali re-wed, re-widowed and shipped to Minnesota in 1866 with children and grands. See item 2 next.
- 2 Mali Hemmingsdtr wed Johan Andreas Svensen in Stjordal and moved south to Strinda Parish where Svend was born in 1837. Johanna Elizabeth too in 1840, but later records wrongly report her of Stjordal and/or Vefsn. Svend must have died: Svend b. 1845 arrived with the family back in Stjordal; he passed that same year. Then her family and Paul's followed Ole's to Nordland. Gurine was born in Vefsn in 1847. They were at Fiplingkrogen Vefsn in 1865. Mali was the first child of Hemming and Guro to leave Stjordal; the only to locate to America. Mystery solved: her husband died on route, told as follows:
- "Those Fiplingkrogen Tales of Mali Hemmingsdatter" on separate emigrations of Mali H and Mali C to MN. Its attachment SivertAndMali.PDF details Mali C's 1st and 2nd families, looks at the process of leaving the old for new world and postulates the generation behind Hemming Sivertsen and Guru Olsdatter in Nord-Trondelag. The PDF is intense with source data.

THE SECOND DISPLAY of the MAIN POST

- a) Paul H's wife, Marit Olsdtr. died in 1849 at Hattfjelldal, then Paul wed Ane Nilsdtr (father: Nils Larsen) in 1851. (No children) Ole H. died at 96 in 1896, and his Ingrid A, in 1884. Paul's son, Hemming wed Ole's daughter, Gurine, setting up our heritage
- b) Child order for Paul: Hemming, Ole, Sivert. For Ole: Mali, Gurine, Ingaborg Anna, Beret, Hemming, Andreas and Elen Oline.
- c) Hemming Paulsen and Gurine Olsdtr lived into the next century, extending our intended 1900 wrap-up mark to 1915.

Second Display Left Side Top Panel: Children of Paul Hemmingsen and Marit Olsdatter

- 1 Sivert Paulson 1844-1936, a Generation 3 emigrant wed Karen Eliz. Mikklesdtr 1839-1920, in 1867. They departed to the US in 1888: Pauline 1870, Mikael 1872, Kristian Gunerius 1874, Ole 1876, [Andreas 1879-1880], Gunhild Anna 1881, Mathea 1883, Martin 1888. There are PHOTOS of the couple at Findagrave.com Ref 11173530 with an interesting abstract from the History of Barron County WI (pub 1922) on their role in Lakeland WI.
- 2 Ole Paulson, a shoemaker, b. 1833E drowned in 1874. Had wed Maren Johanna Christensdtr b 1835 in 1867. Children: Mathea 1861-1877, Marius 1864, Anna 1866, Kristian 1868, Pauline 1870. Mathias 1872-88. In 1885, Maren re-wed to tailor Edvard Zachariassen, likely former partner to Elin Oline Olsd b 1845 (son Edvin Marius 1865-03-05 Hatfjelldal) No children were found from this union. A rough patch followed Ole's death resulting in some foster care, apparent in 1891. Pauline wed Johan Marcilius Nilsen of Sjaavig in 1905 at Vefsn. Last seen: 1907 at Herringbotne at birth of Olav Mathias. Anna Olsdtr b 1866 Uglevand > Mathias Arntsberg Jorgensen of Sjaavig in 1889. At Lamoen in 1910 with surname Sjaavig. Kristian Olsen (of Uglevand) wed Lina Marie Johnsdtr in 1895: Malfred Olitte, b/d 1897/98 when they were living at Unkervand. Johan Kristiansen was born in 1900.
 - Kristian Olsen and his family of three immigrated to America in 1902.
 - Marius Olsen, a road worker, out-migrated to Otofon in 1899.

Second Display Bottom Panel: topline 1865 census data for Paul and Ole's married children at their own homes. Display 3 gives full data for our cousin-spouses, Hemming Paulsen and Gurine Olsdtr, but next generation of all will be discussed.

Second Display Right Side Top Panel: Children of Ole Hemmingsen and Ingrid Arnsdatter

- a) Elen Oline Olsd (Gunder Olsen Dahlby) and Pauline Hemmingsd (Lars Rued) were 7 yrs/a generation apart but great pals.
- Elen Oline's story is posted as "Our Dahlby Family: First Others in Cumberland WI". Pauline followed; so will her story, later.
- 3 •Hemming Olsen b. 27 Feb 1841 in Vefsn, shows Ole Hemmingsen moved from Stjordal ca 1840. Had 3 uegte children with Johanna Marie Mathisdtr (1841-1914) of Sjaavig: Anna 1868 > Benjamin Mathias Danielsen, 1888; Elen Dorthea 1870 > Ottar Olsen Hoff, 1899; Ole 1874-1896. Johanna wed Nils Andreas Thommassen in 1887 of Breiviken. **Update:** Hemming declared he wed (possibly Dorthea Birgithe Nilsdatter b. 1858 Hemnes, Nordland). They left for Wisconsin on 11 APR 1877 where they had a son, Olaf Olsen (1878-1880?). Hemming was a shoemaker in Wisconsin. Story at https://wp.me/p9ORWJ-51Z
- Hemming's 1865 Census indicates he had been insane since he was 23 years old not otherwise confirmed.
- le Ole Hemmingsen, b 1800 and b 1874, died in 1896; grandsire and grandson, scribed one beneath the other on the ledger of death. The younger possibly died of meningitis. Son and father, Hemming Olsen Nerli, b. 1841, had died abroad in 1880.
- 4 Andreas Olsen 1843-1937 wed Karen Anna Larsdatter 1851-1929 in 1872 and headed Nerlid by 1891.
 - * Andreas Olssen Nerli b. 1843 docked in Quebec CA in 1868, but was back in Norway for his 1872 wedding.
 - "Those Fiplingkrogen Tales of Mali Hemmingsdatter" has the account of his trip.
- "Halsesyge" (strep throat?) of 1885 took Lars Fredrick b. 1877, Marie 1879, Berg 1884. Diphtheria of 1895:Olga Marie b 1888 Other Andreasen/dtr children: Olaf Ingeman b 1873. Lina Olivia b 1875 > Hans Marius Hansen in 1896. Hemming A. Nerli b. 1881 > Andrine Jonsdtr Dalen in 1908. Lars Marius Berg 1885. Arnt Kristoffer Berg 1890. Inger Amalia 1892 > Sergeant Lars Fredriksen in 1915. Dagny Lovise 1894 > Gunerius Johnsen in 1917.
- **5-7** Three Olsdatter sisters wed Ole husbands resulting in a confusing bunch of Olsen/dtr cousins. Sisters all born in Stjordal and died in Hatfjelldal, Vefsn or Grane: Mali 1825-1871, Ingeborg Anna 1836-1903, Beret 1838-1876.
- **5** Mali Olsdtr to Ole Anderson (1823-1909) in 1852. At Braenne: Marith Anna 1852, Inger Oline 1854, Ole Andreas 1858 Olianna Maria 1862. Marith Anna > Hans Pedersen b. 1847 Mo I Vaaga in 1870; Petter Andreas b 1870.
 - Hans Pedersen Moe, Marith Anna and Petter Anders to America in 1871 [1880 at Stony Run, MN]
 - Ole Andreas Olsen b 1858 probably immigrated to the US in 1880.
 - Oleanna Marie Olsdtr family with Anders Olsen Hoel migrated to Hemne, Sor-Trondelag by 1891.
- Inger Oline > Ivar Thomassen Lie, 1881, Gronlid: Adolf Teodor 1882, John Edvin 1885, Ottar Sigurd 1887, Minda Gurine 1890
 Uegte: Adolf Marius Amundsen b 1874d. Ole Thorvald Halstensen b. 1875. Anne Marie Olsdtr Ruderas b. 1878.
 IOO > Jonas Olofson 1901, no children. Probably moved to Sweden. Adolf Teodor to BC CA. Story: Maiden Aunts
- 6 Ingeborg Anna Olsdtr > Ole Saxesen [Zak Sak] (b1828E Stjordal-1900+) in 1854 at Forshaugen Vefsn: Daughter 1856d. Susanna Marie 1857. Andreas 1864 and Martin 1868 lost to follow-up. Sivert 1867d. Svend 1871d. Johan 1872d. Ole Mathias Olsen Forshaug b. 1859E > Gurine Andreassen 1856-1894 in 1884. C1900: Ole to Fauske Skjerstad. Children: Anna 1884 > Leonard Larsson, 1910; Olaf Andreas 1885 > Elda Lund Nilsdtr, 1909; Ingeborg Anna 1888 > Ottar Mathias Olsen in 1911. Bergithe b. 1890 was unmarried in 1920, with Ottar and her sister in Hattfjelldal.
 - •Susanna Marie to Cumberland WI ca 1880. Wed Hans Howe at home of Aunt Elin Oline; see blogpost Our Dahlby Family
- **7** Beret Olsdtr to Ole Olsen (1830E Meraker-1913) in 1860. Family at Bratlid 1865 thru 1920. Children: Albert Olaus 1864-67. Oleana b.1867 > Edwin Marius Kristiansen in 1890. Johan Mathias b. 1873 > Helen Andrea Pettersdtr in 1902. Minda Sofie b. July 1875, was fostered by Anders Anderson at Tjolmen > Olaus Jorgen Bek Karstensen at Tjolmen in 1905.
 - Inger Anna Olsdtr b 1865 immigrated to the US in 1899.
 - Albert Olaf Olssen Bratlid b. 1869, migrated to Sweden in 1900.
 - •Ole Olsen Bratli b. 1871 migrated to Mo Nord-Rana in 1904 > Anna Sofie Charlotte Pedersen b. abt 1885


WHERE THEY LIVED IN TOWN

Hattfjelldal had three Census Districts in 1865. Paul H was in CD 001 Hatfjelddalen; RR 0023 Ugelvatne/Hemming Paulsen was next to him at RR 0024 Grorli/Matis Bentson, at CD 001; RR 0002 Hatfjelddalen/ Ole Hemmingsen in CD 002 Susendalen; RR 0007 Nelderlie/Alette Ingebrigtsdtr (future step-g-grandmother) in CD 003 Rytsvandet; RR 0013 Tustervatne. There were separate school districts within each census district. Redistricting happened as the town grew, such that subsequent censuses would see updated naming stucture. Over time, surnames became associated with the RR 0000

THE THIRD DISPLAY of the MAIN POST

Trondelag was our dominant heritage. Hemmingson and Hemmingsen names went forward in the US and Canada respectively. At Gen. 3, Trondelag-Trondelag met Nordland-Oppland; Bentson-Jonsdtr. This slide shows them and Gen 4, our great-grandparents, Ole Mathias Hemmingsen and Beret Has Mathisdtr with their siblings. We can visualize the evolving family diaspora. Ole left for WI in 1882, Beret 1886, Granddad 1887. Granddad's Gen. 5 will follow for best flow. Finally Gens 1 and 2 of Oppland and Nordland will be presented. Note: Bentson was a short form of Bendigtsen.

- a) Bentson /Bendigtsen had various spellings, also Vaagaa/Vaage/Vågå Oppland.
- b) Matis Bentson died in 1884, Marit Jonsdatter in 1894. They twice blended Nordland-Oppland genes with Trondelag.
- c) Pauline Hemmingsdtr and Lars Rued left for WI USA early 1880s. Brother Ole and wife Beret followed as neighbors.
- d) Matias Martinus M and Anna Oline H went to Iowa in 1888. The story is blogged. Sverre M travelled with them.
- e) Hans Matias and Benjamin M A Matisson have a story: Uncle's PHOTO but for a decade? https://wp.me/p9ORWJ-3aL



Third Display Left Side: Family of Mathis Bentson/Bendigtsen [Nordlander] and Marit Jonsdatter [Opplander]

- 1 All children had moved or passed on when Mother died in 1894, except for Johan Olaus Matisson (1850-1908). He had had Marit Jacobia (1878-79) with Lovise Vilhelmina Andersdtr uegte. He married Petrine Marie Olsdtr in 1882. Son Torger, born 1884 wed Lina Marie Larsdtr in 1908; they still had **Hatfjelddalen Farm in family hands at 1920**. Daughter Marit Johansdtr, b. 1883, wed Trithjof Norman Thomassen, in Otofon P in 1903. Rangdi b 1886, wed Johan Eibert Nilsen, in 1908.
- 2 Torger Christian Mathissen died in 1882. No reason was entered.
- **3** Maren Jorgine Mathisdtr (1856-1918/geni.com) wed Ole Mikal Nilsen b 1854 in 1879. The went to Tarnia Sweden in 1887 with Elen 1880, Torger 1882, Marie 1884, Nikoline 1886. Also Einar 1879-80. Geni.com has a small **PHOTO** of her
- **4** Marie Lovise Mathisdtr died April 1884 of pneumonia, just weeks after her father succumbed to bronchitis . She wed Bendict Mathias Sivertsen in 1880 Mosjoen: Signe Mathilde same year, last seen 1891 with grandparents and father.

Third Display Right Side: Family of Hemming Paulsen and Gurine Olsdatter

- 5 Mathias Hemmingsen 1859-1883 died of "chest disease".
- **6!** Elen Hemmingsdtr 1855-1880, at Groli. Her Inger Mathilde Gustavsdtr b 1874 died of measles at just 8 months. Elen never wed her partner. She joins sister Anne Marie and cousin Inger Oline in a story on the hardships of young women when a large male population suddenly migrates in and out. *Circa granddad's birth, it also presents the history of Groli*.
 - "Maiden Aunts and the Skovdrivers of Hattfjelldal Parish"
- 7 Anne Marie Hemmingsdtr (1857-1949) wed Laurits Johnsen in 1884 at Grorli. At Elsvand: Ragnvald Mathias 1885, Gunda Jorgine 1887, Elen Mathilde 1890. At Aasen: Johan Ingemann 1893, Paul 1895, George Edvin 1897, Ingaborg Anna 1900, Hjalmar 1903. Hemming Gustavsen (1877-1966) was Anne Marie's son by Gustav Henriksen. See item 6 above for more Lauritsdtrs Gunda Jorgine b 1887 and Elen Mathilde b 1890 died of diphtheria which had hit our farms in 1895.
 - Hemming Gustavsen immigrated to Alaska in 1905. His story is blogged as "A Life Larger Than Lean"
- 8 Ingeborg Anna Marie Hemmingsdtr (1861-91) wed Olaus Olsen in 1880 and resided with her parents at Grorli. He left her widowed with Sigurd Edvin 1880, Marie 1881 and Olav 1882. She wed Olaus Nilsen in 1885. Their Hemming b. 1887 died within days and Elen Nikolina b. 1889, in 1891, a month before her mother, who died of TB. Marie wed Ingebrigt Olaus Larsen; the family at Perjorden Vefsen in 1910. Olav went to Sara Hemmingsdtr at Ungelvand, but died in 1908. Sigurd Edvin remained at Groli and weathered a tough time. He was a father at 14, to a woman five years his senior. That he was yet unconfirmed, seemed a concern. He became an unwed father again in 1898, and again to an older woman. That child, Susanne, did not survive. **Update:** Olaus Nilsen's younger brother, Magnus and wife Albertine asssumed Groli, and cared Hemming and Gurine. Their descendants own the farm today.
 - Sigurd Edvin Olaussen immigrated to US per his son's confirmation record, and may merit a story for resilience.
- 9 Sara Hemmingsdtr (1867-1940) wed Ivar Ivarsen b 1858, at Ugelvand 1920 with Sverre Julius b 1899, Anna 1909 Arne 1910. Haldor Gunerius 1899-?. Askel Andreas 1887 > Sofie Henriette Petersdtr 1909. Ingeborg Anna Elina 1894 > Karl Andersen 1914. Julius Peter 1892-95 diphtheria. Sigfrid 1897-98 whooping cough, Ivar Anker 1902-03 "?", Gurina 1904-05 sepsis.

1884-1979 (Nelson BC) > Milde Andreasdt. Bjorkas b1908 d. after 1988. To Yakh B.C. CA in 19

Hattfjelldal was not found in Census 1875, so missed recently married Ole and Beret, with Henriette at Groli. They moved to Hemnes and Hatfjelddalen before emigrating. The chart below covers both wives and all children of Ole. Beret was ill and died soon after George was born. Ole then wed Alette Emilie Bergith Ingebrigtsdatter of Tustervand.

Einar was born on Hatfjelddalen in 1882 as Ole embarked for WI. Beret probably spent the next four years there, seeing her mother through early widowhood. She left with the three youngest in 1886. This was probably the last home in Norway for Henriette and Mathias in their year of waiting to join their family in Wisconsin.

The blog has photos of Ole, Henriette, Einar/Ed, George. As well, Alette Ingebrigtsdtr and her children.

■ The Farm: This seems a good place to show what the children were used to. In 1865, Matis Bentson had 2 horses 10 cows, 9 sheep, 3 geese and 14 reindeer. His mother had reindeer too; 6. He planted barley and potatoes. Matis was a tenant farmer on this land with one building at Census District 001 Hatfjelddalen-Rural Residence 0002 Hatfjelddalen.

THE FOURTH DISPLAY of the MAIN POST

No reason is known for our Opplander-ancestor trek to Nordland between 1829 and 1836. They beat the Trondelagers!

- a) Marit Hansdtr d 1836 at 48 in Susendahl. Jon Torgersen re-wed in 1839, that record revealing his ancestry. In Vaga Oppland: marriage in 1808; Torger 1810, Marit 1815, Marit 1820, Hans 1823, John 1825 and Hans 1829.
- b) Marit Jonsdatter died at Hattfjelldal in 1894. The burial record Jan 1895 cited Vaage I Gudbransdalen, 1819, for birth. Re: Marit birth 1815, 1820. No death record for first. Mother surname is wrong for second.
- c) Marit Jonsdtr's brother Torger b 1810, a Generation Three emigrant, was key to blogpiece "Uncle's PHOTO".
- d) 1801 census for Vågå Ulevolden: Torger Hansen and Kari Jonsdatter at 54 and 49, no children present.
- e) 1801 census for Vågå, Hougen: Hans Arnesen ≈1749, Mari Olsdtr ≈1762 with 4 children, including Marith
- f) Spouses for Generation 3 were not necessarily from Oppland, with Matis Bentson being a local Nordlander.

THE FIFTH DISPLAY of the MAIN POST

- a) Bendigt Jonsen and Beret Andersdtr did not have to go far to meet each other. Census 1801 of Hatfjelddalen in Vefsn listed Anders Nielsen and Lucia Larsdtr as household 1 and Jon Olsen and Maren Larsdatter as household 2.
- b) Anders and Jon were "peasants with farm animals". Humble Gen 1 came with big plans.
- c) Jon Olsen's mother, KIERSTI PERSDATTER, born abt 1741 was among them in 1801. [Yes, she is pre-Generation 1]
- d) Spouses for Generation 3 were not necessarily from Nordland, with Marit Jonsdtr an intake from Oppland.
- e) Matis Bentson's sister Jonella/Jonetta Bendigtsdtr was a Generation 3 emigrant

Migrant data was usually first found in Norwegian CB under utflyttar and innflyttar. More complete information is found in various Emigrant Protocols at DA but seemed more easily entered through FamilySearch.org.
